24. Pray for the meeting with pro-life supporters in **Rockhampton** on 19th May and for bookings to be made in **Bundaberg**. Pray for God to open doors of opportunity.
 25. Praise God for the opportunity to speak at **Wycliffe Christian School**, Warrimoo (Blue Mountains west of Sydney). Pray for open hearts amongst the Year 10 students.
 26. Pray for plans that are well under way for a first visit to **Adelaide** and other areas of South Australia. Praise God for positive contacts that are being followed up in schools and churches.
 27. Praise God for the email received from **Rashelle**. She is a young mum and has a desire to take the message of the value of life to schools in **Brisbane**. Pray as Bruce has opportunity to meet and encourage Rashelle and her husband Zayn.
 28. Pray for the lady in **Hobart** who expressed a desire to tell her personal experience with an abortion decision. She is keen to take her story into the secondary schools as part of the presentation.
 29. Pray for **Life Network Australia** (www.lifenetw.ork.org.au) as it seeks to provide information on **pro-life groups across Australia**. Sonja and Linda are actively promoting the activities of a number of groups such as Choices of Life.
 30. Praise God for the openings into **Catholic Schools in Tasmania**. Bruce was organised to speak at St Virgil's Catholic College in Hobart and, with the approval of the Archbishop, hopes to reach Catholic schools across the state.
 31. Pray for opportunities in **State Primary schools in NSW**. Bruce is in discussion with Homebush West, Heathcote East and also in Mudgee (2 hours west of Sydney). Bruce has also spoken at **Public schools in Victoria**. Pray for support from Principals and staff for the program.

Next, he was shown a photo of an embryo showing arms, hands, fingers, legs, feet, toes, a head, eyes, etc. The caption said, "**Fifty days.**" The gynaecologist continued, "Around the fiftieth day, the embryo takes on the form of a human being. Zola thought, "That's Pentecost!"

The next picture showed the embryo at seven months. The gynaecologist said, "**On the first day of the seventh month, the baby's hearing is developed. For the first time, it can hear and distinguish sounds outside the womb.**" Zola knew that was the date for the Festival of Trumpets.

The gynaecologist continued, "**On the tenth day of the seventh month, the haemoglobin of the blood changes from that of the mother, to a self-sustaining baby.**" Zola thought, "That's the Day of Atonement, when the blood was taken into the Holy of holies!"

Next, the gynaecologist said, "**On the fifteenth day of the seventh month, the lungs become fully developed.**" And Zola thought, "That's the festival of Tabernacles, a time of celebrating the Temple, home of the Shekinah glory or Spirit of God." In the New Testament, the Greek term pneuma, normally translated as "breath," is applied to the "Holy Spirit."

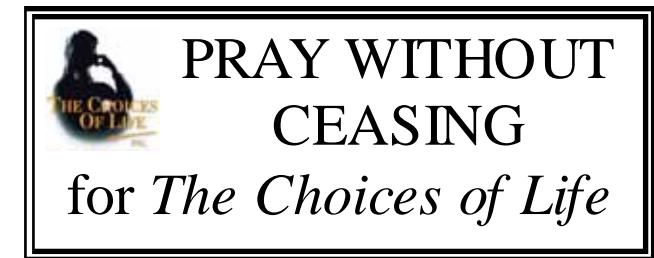
Birth normally takes place on the tenth day of the ninth month. Zola noted that the eight days of Hanukkah are celebrated right on schedule, nine months and ten days after Passover.

GOD'S AMAZING PLAN OF LIFE!

"Zola Levitt discovered an amazing correlation between Biblical Holy Days and the gestation of a human baby, from conception to birth. While



preparing for writing a book for new parents, Zola contacted a gynaecologist for some help in understanding gestation. The gynaecologist showed him a series of pictures and pointing to the first one (an egg and a sperm) he said, "**On the fourteenth day of the first month, the egg appears.**"

The statement struck a chord in his Jewish mind because that was the date of Passover. He remembered the roasted egg on his family table every Passover. Now, for the first time, he knew what it meant! Not wanting to lead the gynaecologist off from the subject at hand, he didn't say anything, but continued to listen.

The gynaecologist continued: "**The egg must be fertilized within 24 hours, or it will pass on.**" This reminded Zola of the Feast of Unleavened Bread and the seed or grain that "fell into the ground and died" in order to produce a harvest, the first fruits of which was presented to God.

Next, the gynaecologist said, "**Within two to six days, the fertilized egg attaches itself to the wall of the womb and begins to grow.**" And, sure enough, Zola thought, "The Feast of First fruits (Sfiyat Haomer) is observed anywhere from two to six days after Passover!"
